Recently we were called back to Pittsburgh to wait along with family for my mother-in-law to graduate to glory. Ruth was 92, suffering from congestive heart failure & other complications. The waiting was quite stressful as family members disagreed on procedures & where mom would spend her final days. The knowledge that we did not want to face grief disjointed from one another & that it would grieve mom for us to be at odds kept us swallowing our pride & making aestures of support.

We were waiting for mom's suffering to end. We were waiting to begin the real work of grief. We were sad, waiting to get sadder.

Jesus asks his followers to wait for an experience that will bring great joy & empowerment to their spiritual lives: the Baptism in the Holy Spirit. We are not to wait passively but seek that experience through prayer.

Sometimes we're waiting for good things to happen, sometimes we're waiting for bad stuff to occur. Either way, waiting is itself an experience. It requires self-discipline; it requires patience; it requires faith. It's alright to think about other things, to take care of necessary business, but the focus of our waiting is ever present in our thinking. Keep thinking about more power coming from the Holy Spirit to fuel your life.
