After lugging our luggage to the car we learned that all the surrounding streets were closed until after the race. Did you know it takes some people over an hour to run ... or walk ... 3.1 miles?

It was very dark by the time we were released. I got befuddled with the directions. We looped around the entire city; we were lost, seemingly to spend the rest of our lives circling the nation's capital. My head started to hurt, my heart was pounding, I was getting angry at road signs, angry at whoever it was that decided to run a 5k in the middle of a city, angry at road design engineers ...

That's a little bit what it's like whenever you get disconnected from the Lord: you get lost. Your head starts to spin, anger becomes an issue; nothing works the way you planned. Come home. Stop running around in circles & come home – the Father's arms are open wide.
